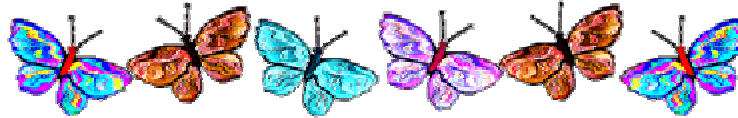


Deadline for Voices of Siskiyou Haiku Contest
